CDC app includes vaccines needed for international travel

An app from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention called TravWell helps international travelers build a trip and get destination-specific vaccine recommendations. Additionally, the app provides a travel preparation checklist and customizable healthy travel packing list.

Other features of the free app include the ability to store travel documents, keep a record of traveler medications and immunizations, and set reminders to get vaccine booster doses or take medications when traveling.

The app also includes recommendations from the CDC, travel features available offline and emergency services phone numbers for every destination.
